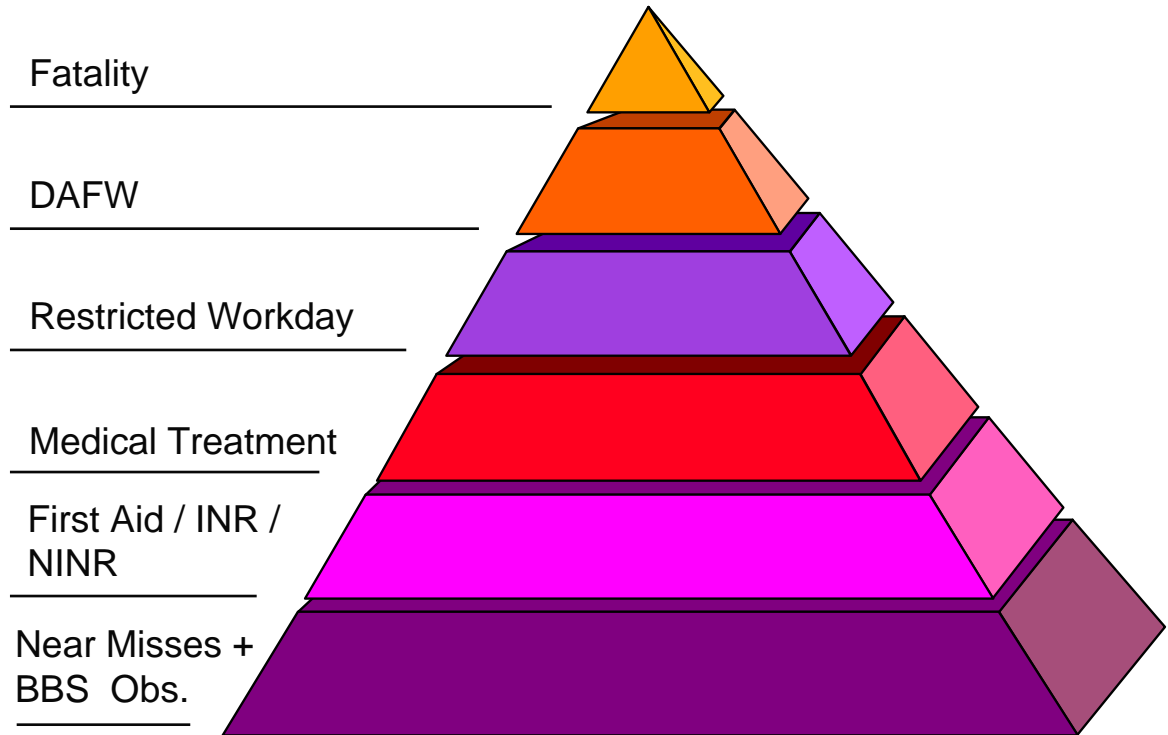

Strong Reporting of Incidents

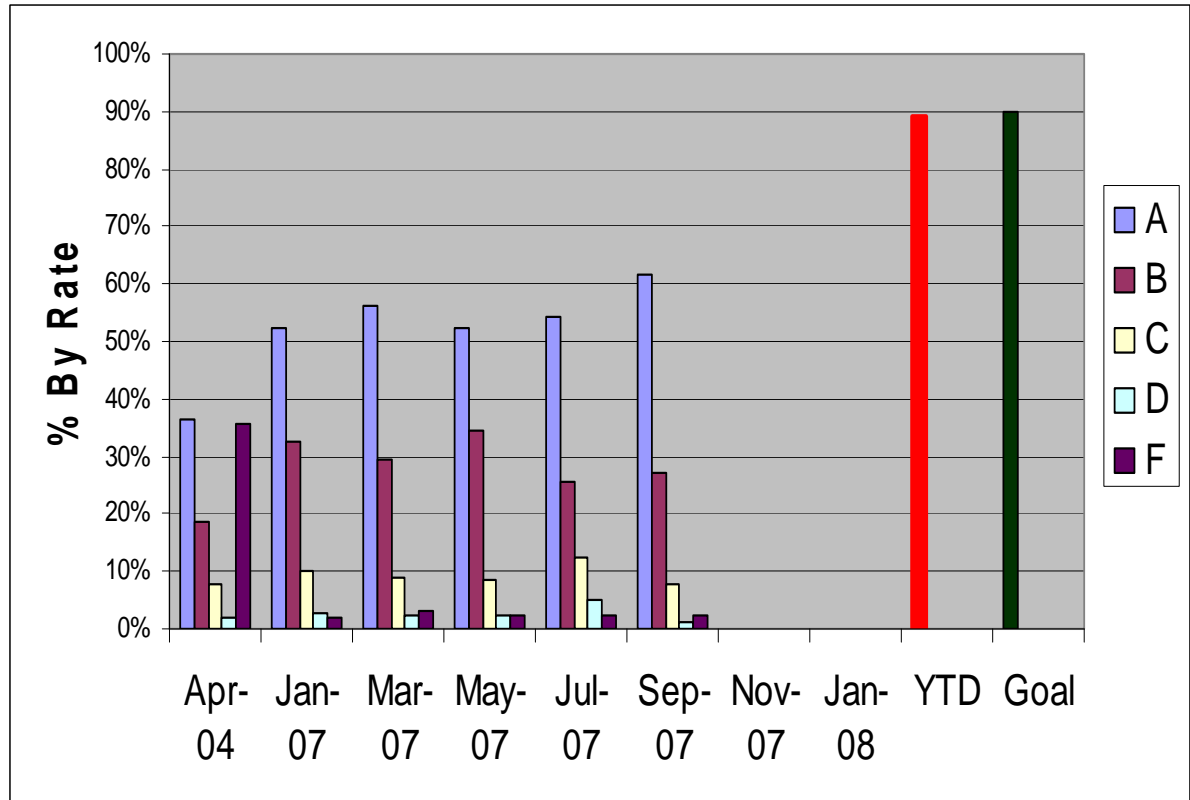
2007 Injury/Illness Pyramid (thru October)

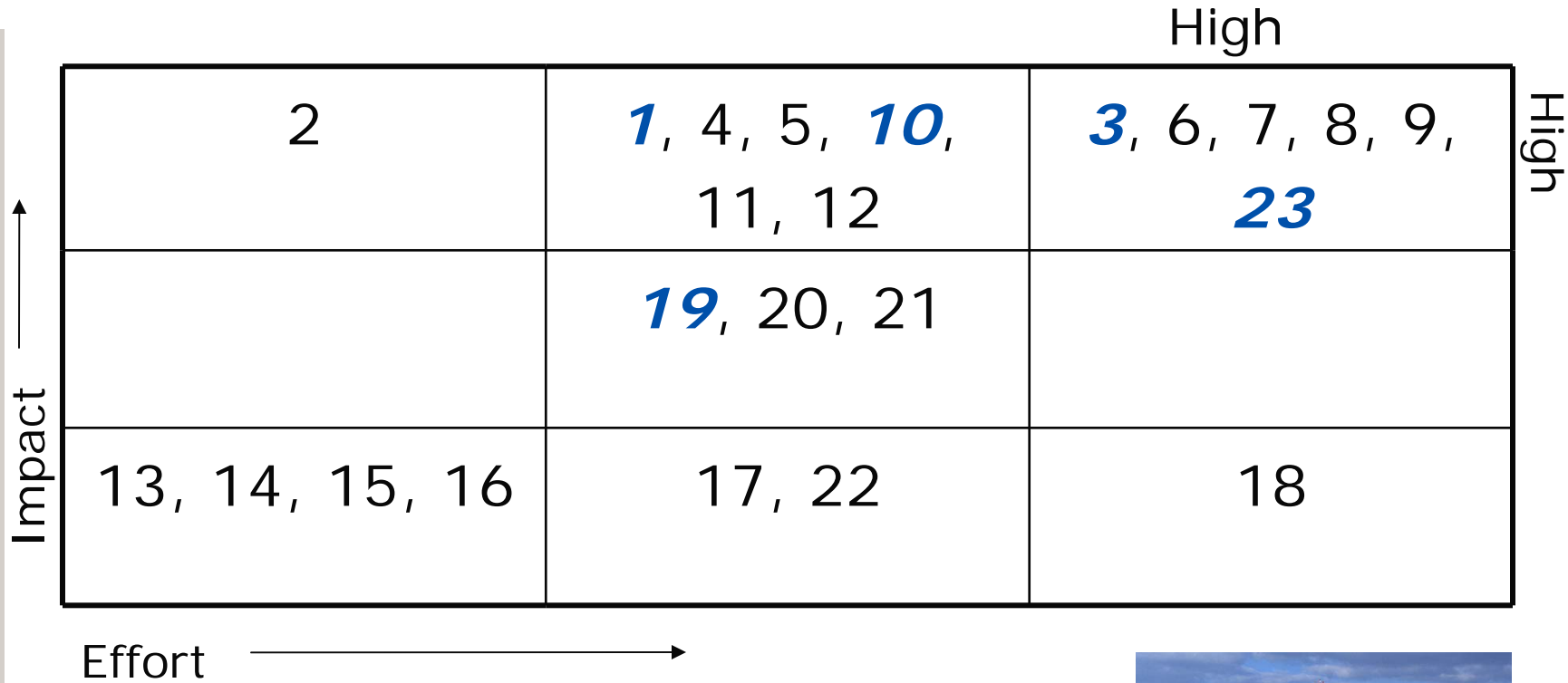
Contractor Safety Leadership Team Actions

Develop a list of measures that will move the bar for GOM safety performance

- Major Hazards Review
 - Safe Work Practices , Risk Recognition, Oversight
- Root Cause Discussion
 - Safe Work Practices (Hot Work, LOTO, Heights/Falls), Risk Recognition (snap decisions, routine activities), Oversight (~300 Chevron and 2500 Contractors)

Top five	Impact	Rank
Revamp and revitalize our IFO sessions.	H	5
Increase expectations of contractor management offshore visibility. Contractor KPI's should include metrics, and visibility	H	4
Focus on processes impacting people directing or overseeing work	H	3
Conduct periodic meetings for contractor and Chevron management according to product service line (e.g. diving industry, construction, D&C, etc.. High Level)	H	2
Increase audit expectations and feedback on JSA's. Too many "check the box", and "group" JSA's in use... Assign specific people to job tasks on JSA	H	1
